

Cut & Stick or laminate for sorting

There are 12 pictures to sort which is a lot to keep control of when cutting and sticking, therefore....

1. The two sheets can be given out separately. When sheet one has been sorted and completed the children can find sheet two for them selves. Or continue another day.
2. All the pictures are numbered so the children know which 'bits' are theirs or which 'bit' they have missing. (spare sheets ready cut out and available centrally is recommended for those who lose pieces)
3. The children need to know that the pictures are numbered out of sequence – they will not go from 1-12 when they are in the correct order!
4. The answers are below.

The correct sequence for sheet one is:

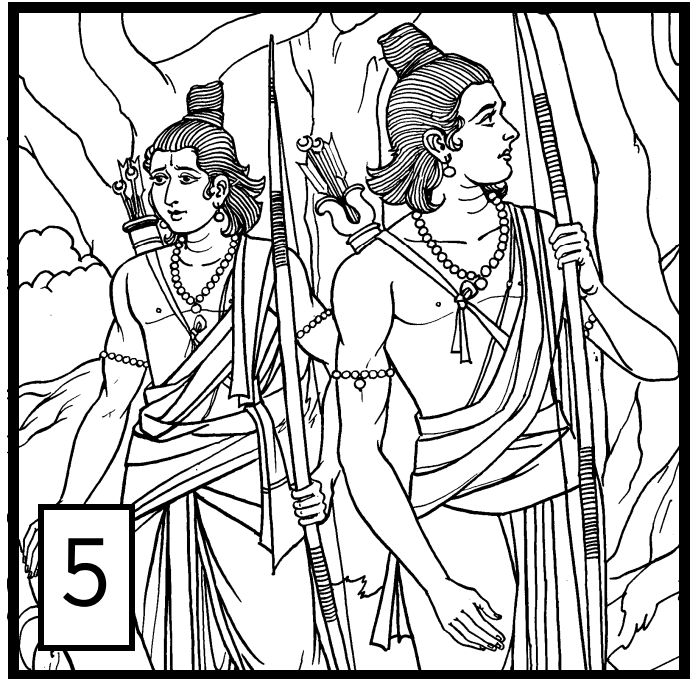
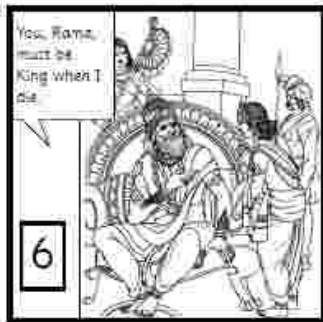
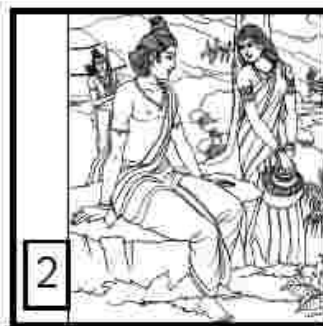
6 - 3 - 2 - 1 - 4 - 5
