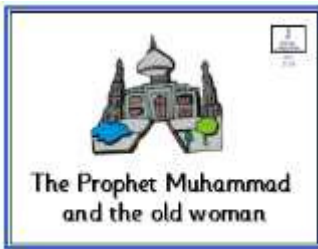


164. Muslim Story PowerPoint Two
