

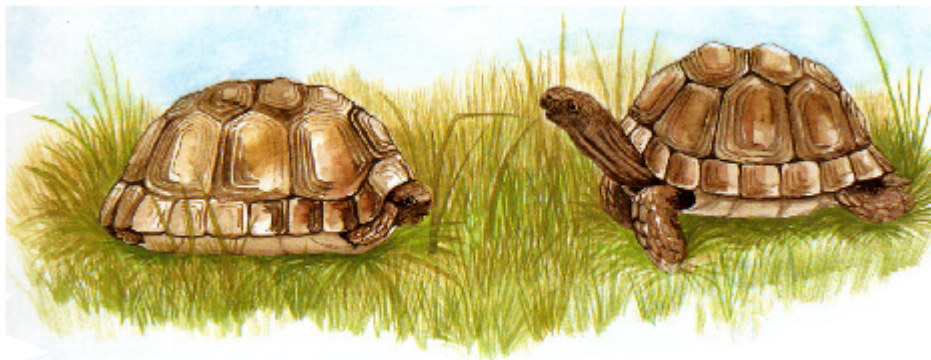
Some animals don't need to make a home, they carry their home with them. A snail has a shell that is part
