The fly has married the bumblebee.



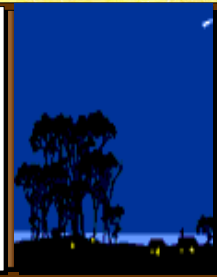
I had a little nut tree,

couldn't catch me.



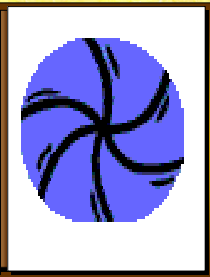
The swan swam over the sea,

We all fall down.



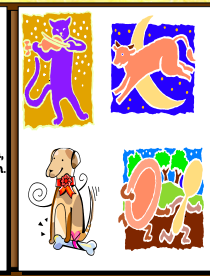
Good night, sleep tight,
