Earwigs are food for frogs, hedgehogs and birds.

Slugs feed on plants and animal dung.

Slugs are food for birds, badgers, foxes and beetles.

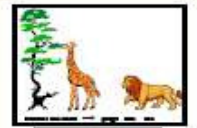
Earthworms feed on dead and rotting plant material.

Earthworms are food for moles, birds, hedgehogs, frogs and badgers.

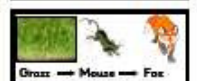
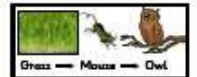
Woodlice feed on dead wood and plants.

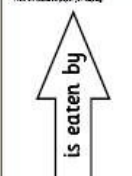
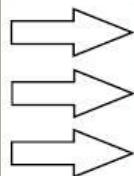
