






Dusty writes his report

Dusty discovered that people on Earth read **non-chronological reports** to find out **information about things**. It was a very good way of sharing information with others.




Dusty knew that if he could remember how to write a report, his friends would be able to read about some of his discoveries.


Dusty decided that it was time to send a report to his friends in the space craft factory.

Dusty thought hard.....




