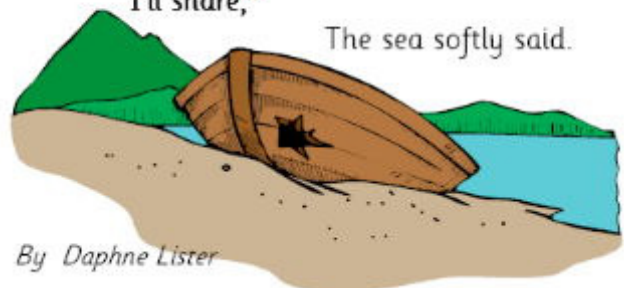
### The Sea's treasures
